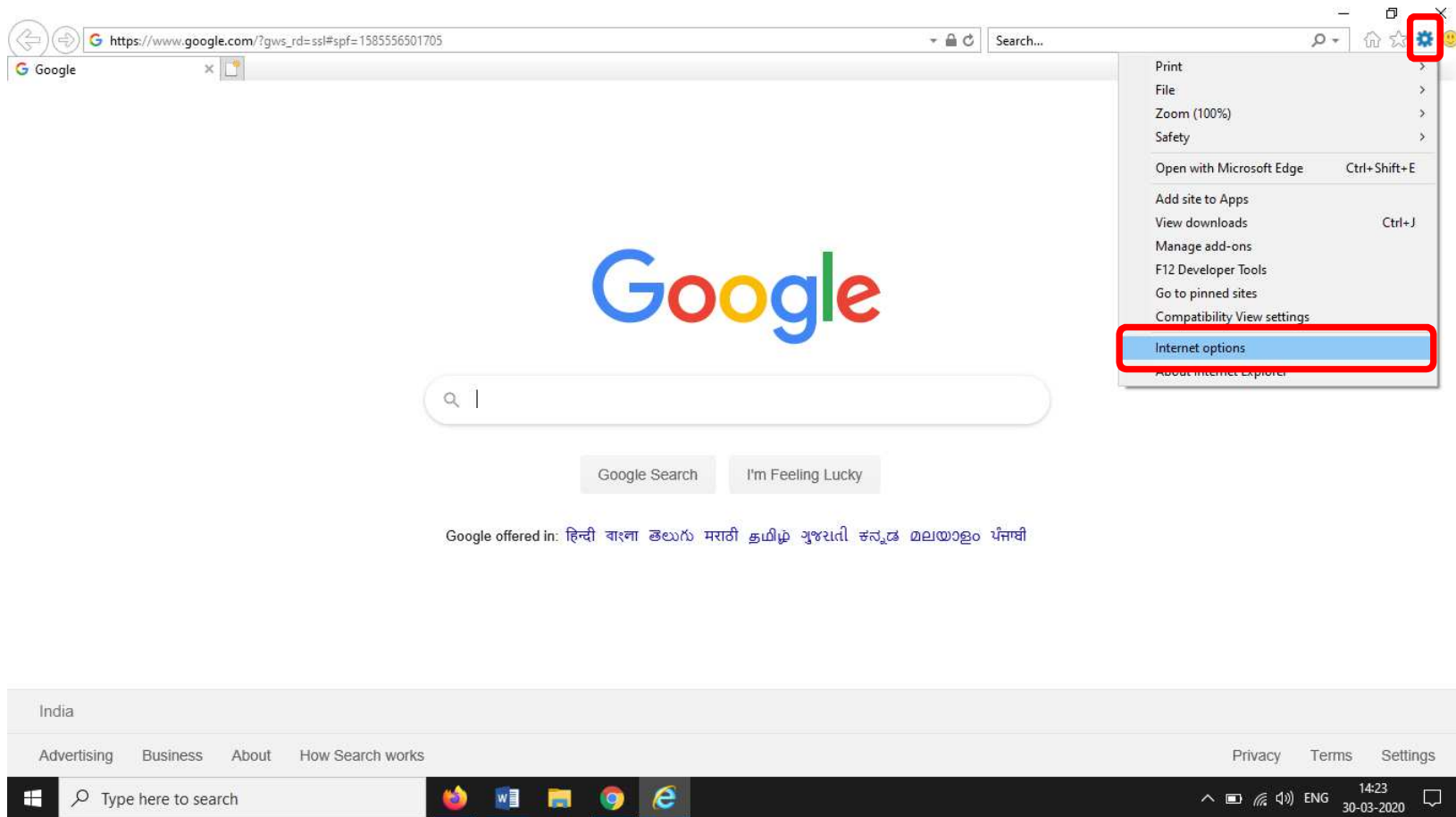

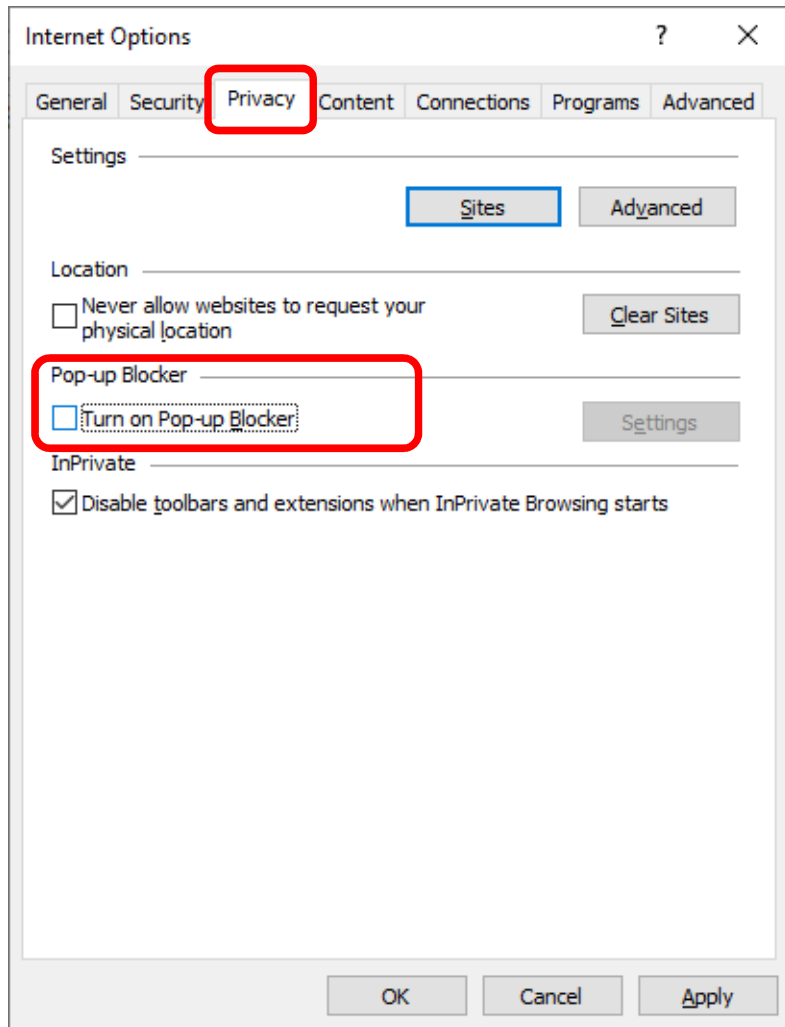

#### Go to Settings



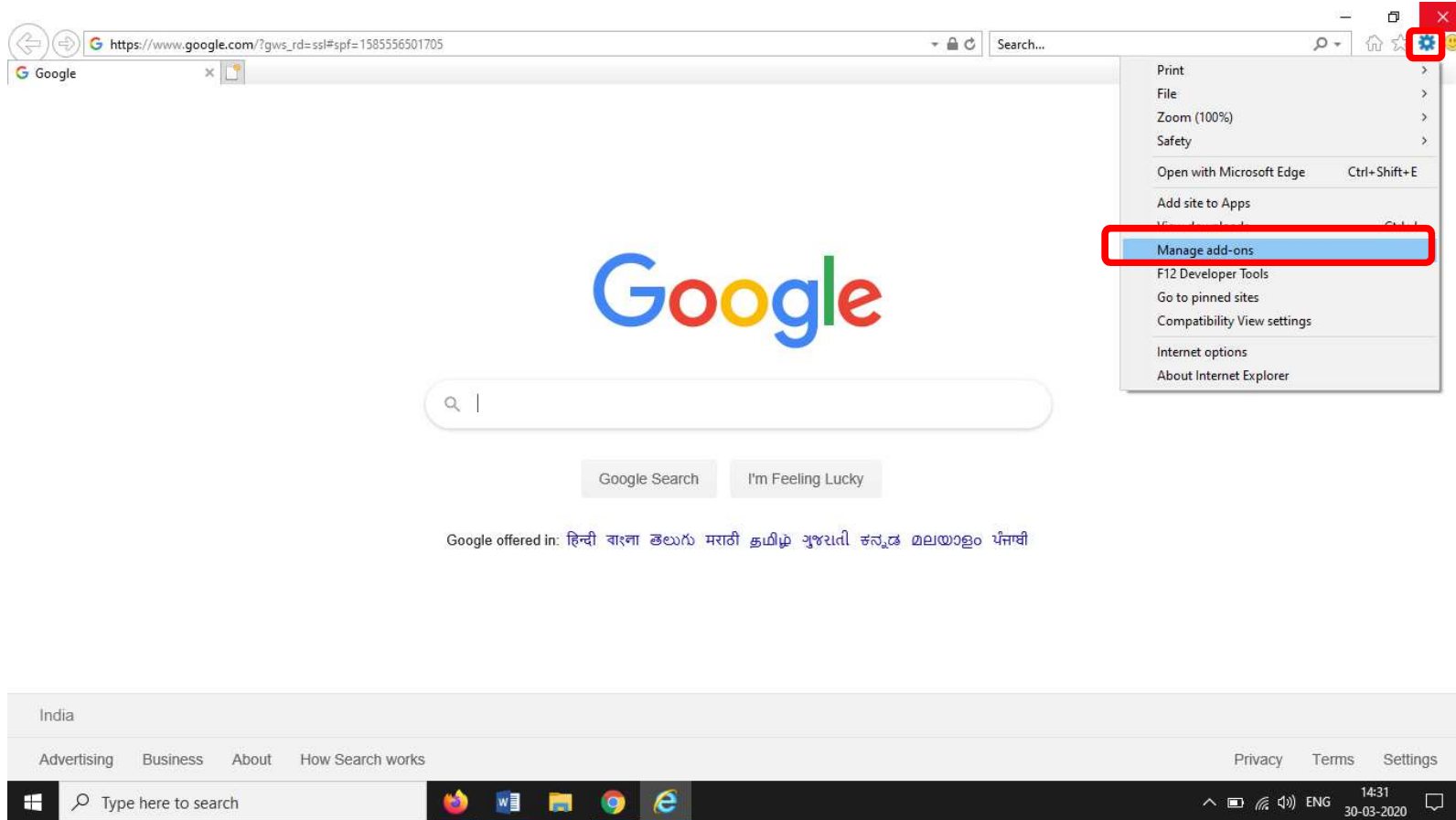
Select "Privacy" tab -> Un-check "Turn on Pop-up Blocker" to enable pop-up windows. (Remove tick  mark)



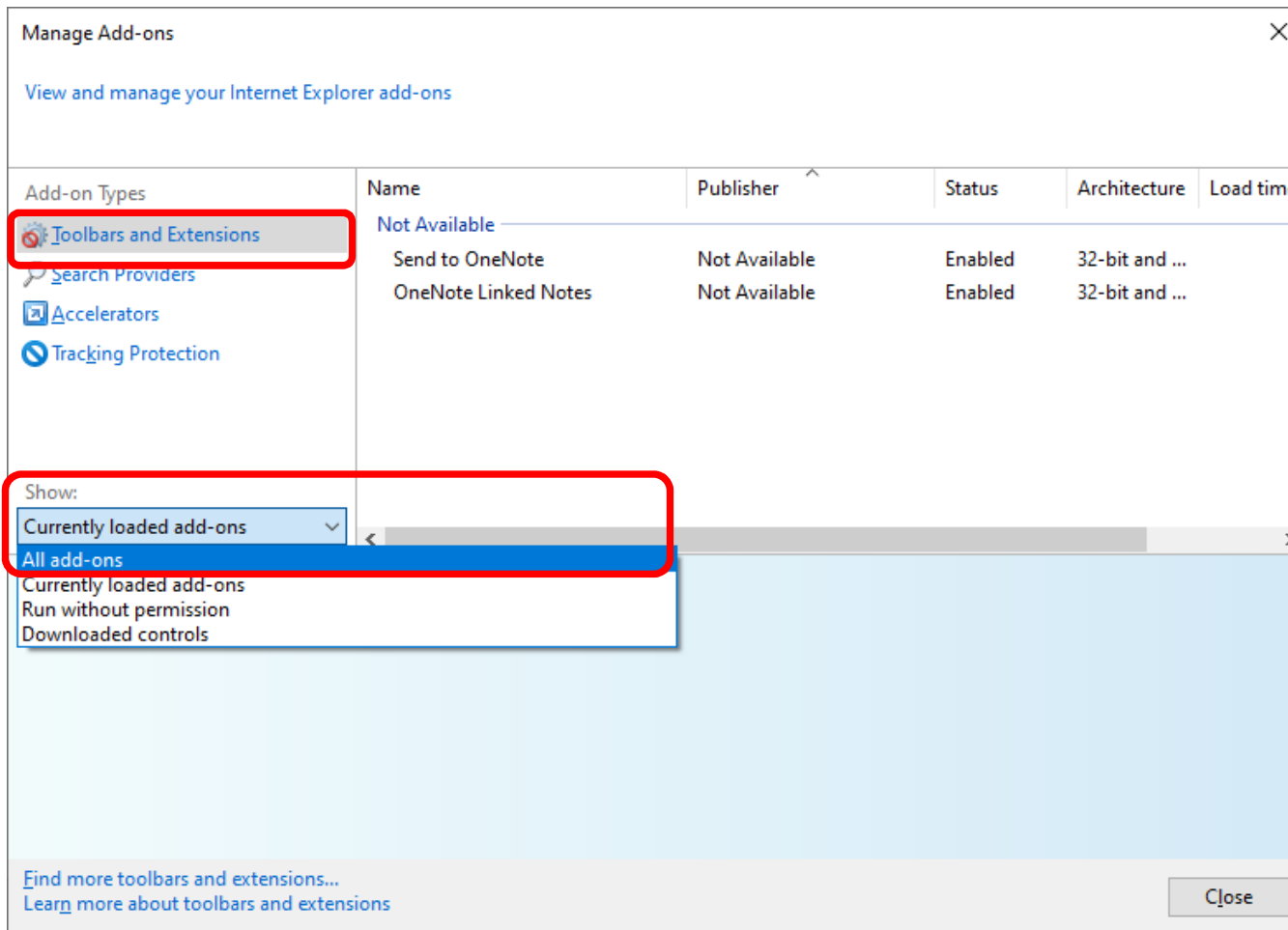
### Enabling Flash

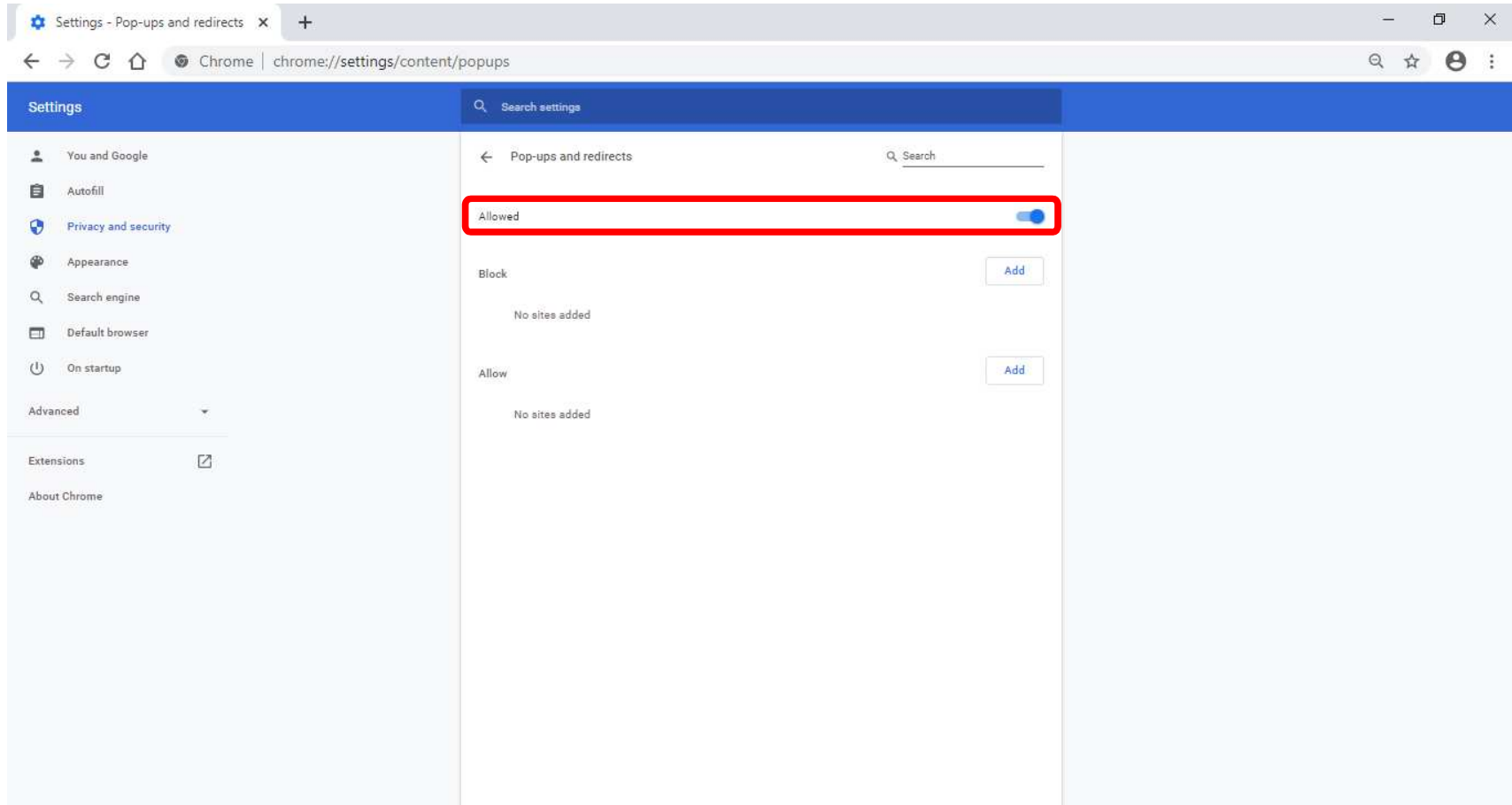
## Enabling Pop-up windows

In “Privacy and Security” -> Select “Pop-ups and redirects”, it the options shows as “Allowed”, the browser will open popups.

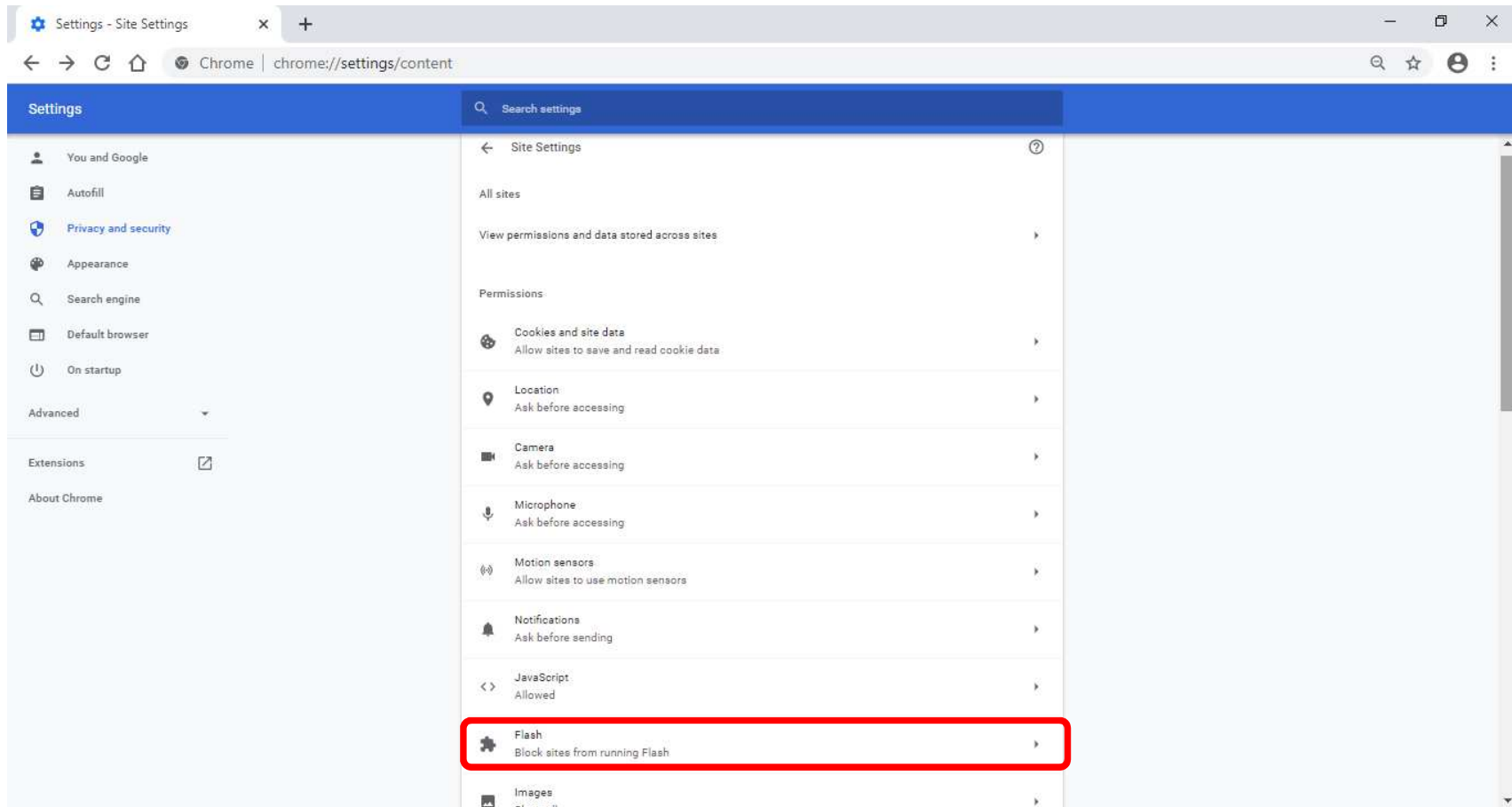




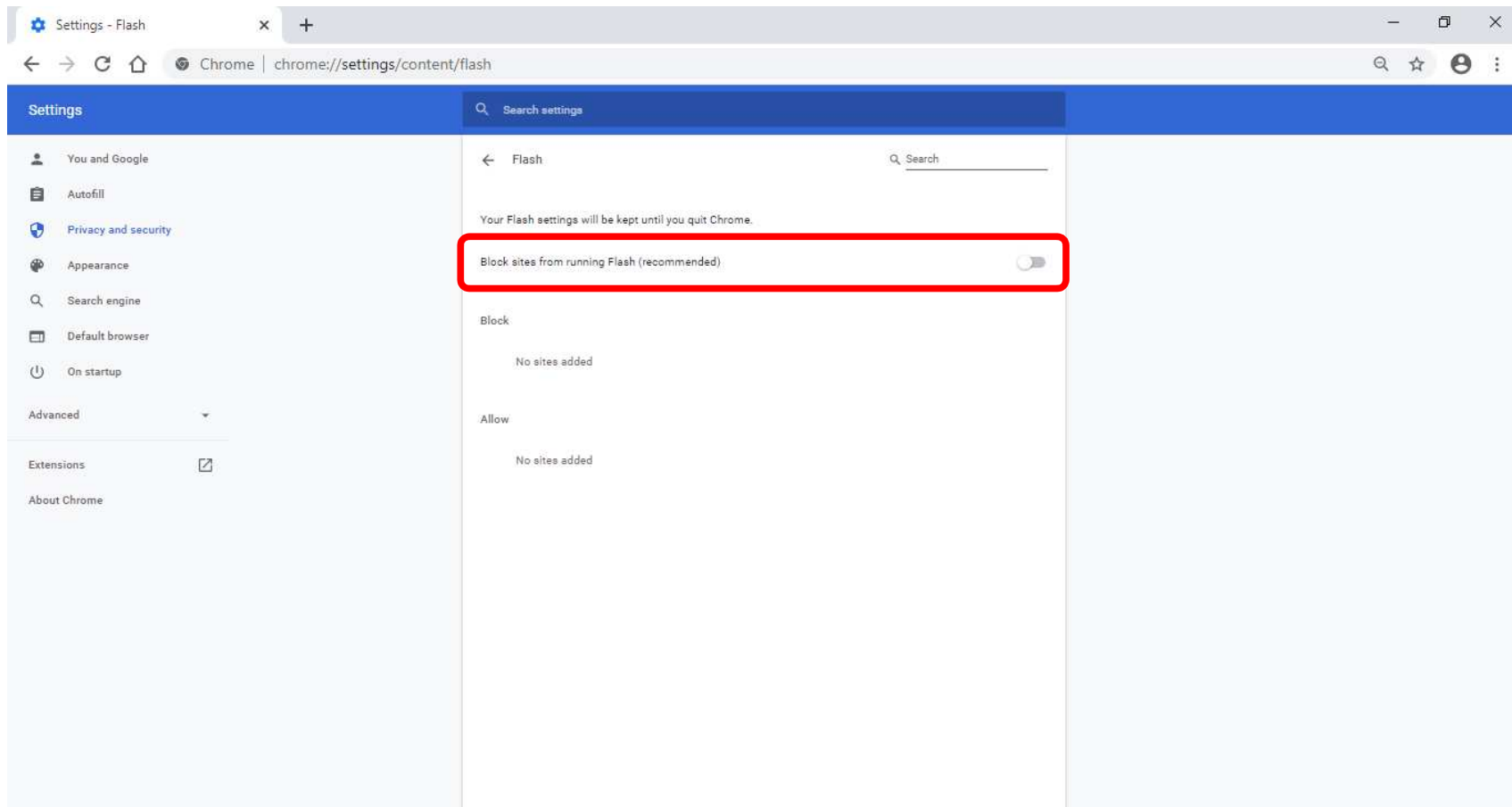
## Enabling Flash

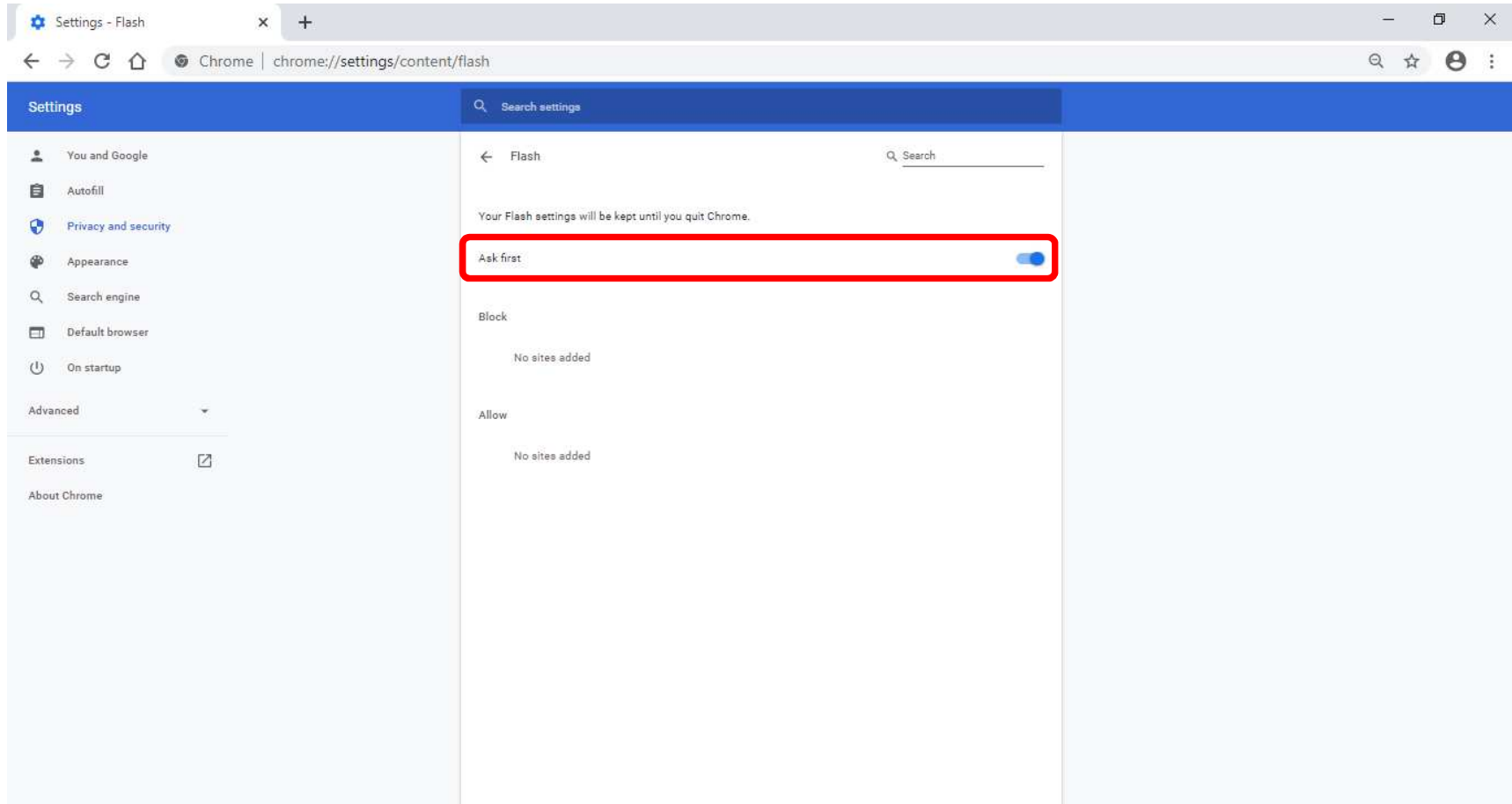
Go to Settings -> Privacy and Security -> Flash Settings

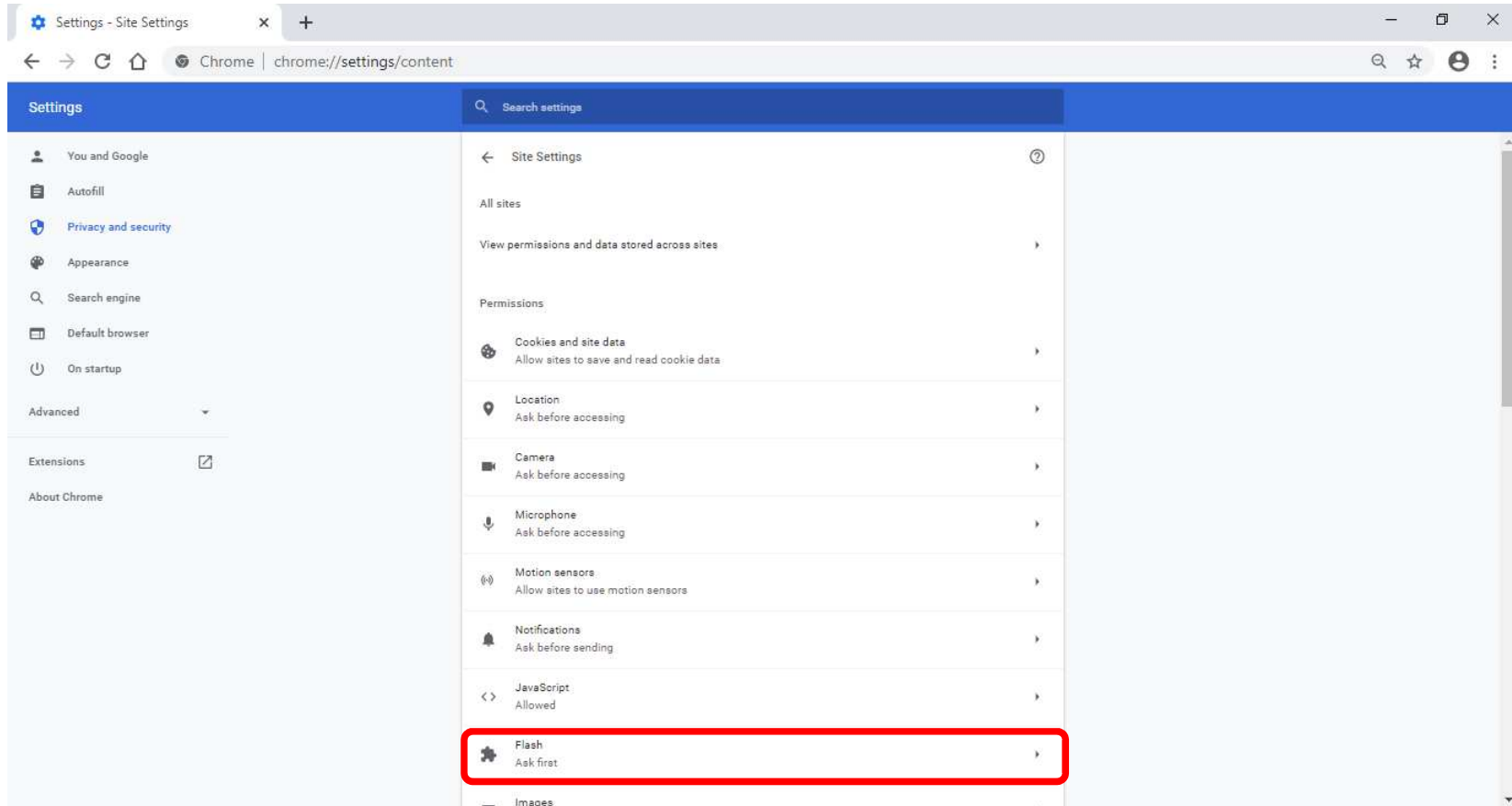

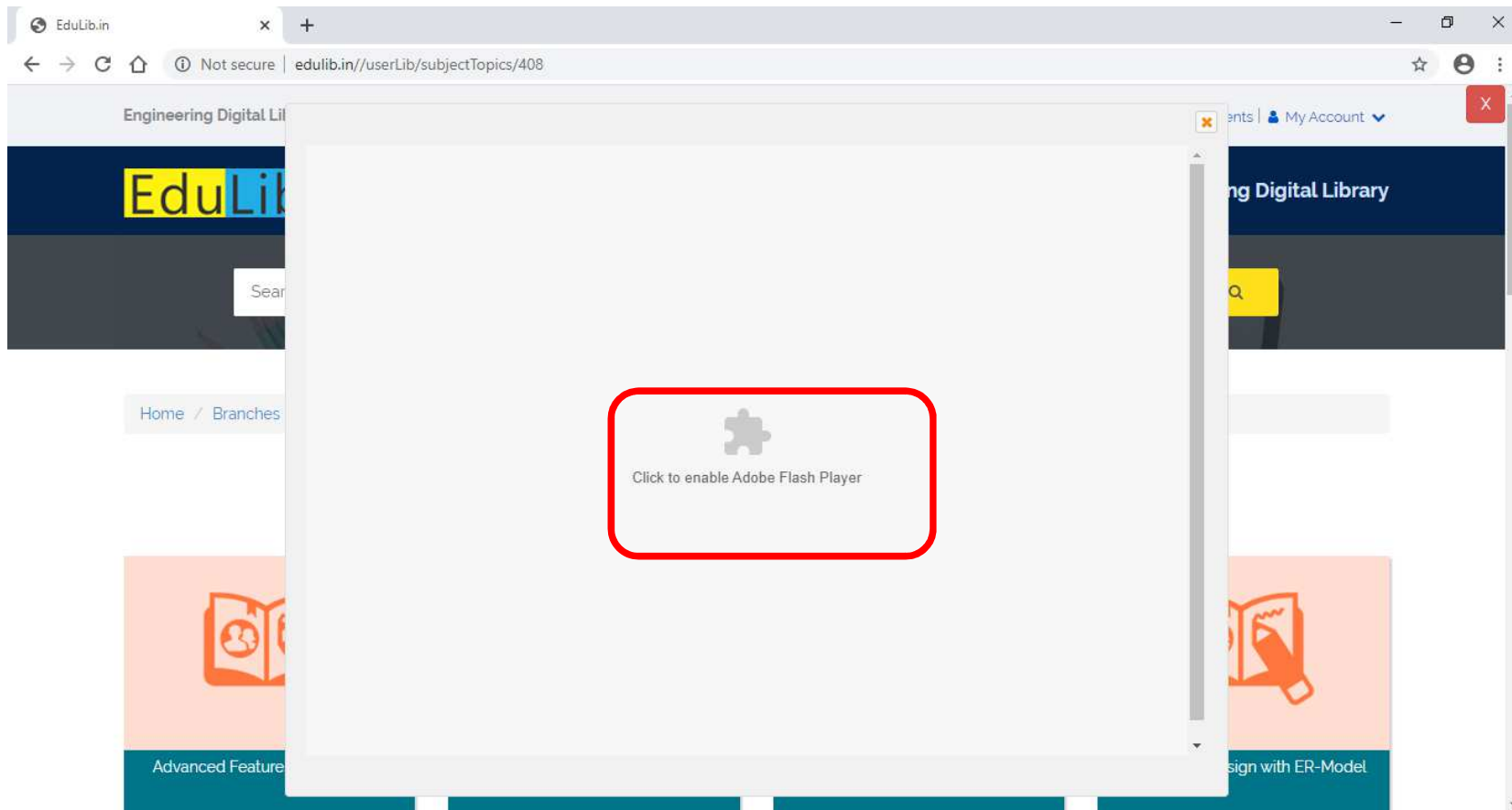
If the current settings are blocked, enable it from here.





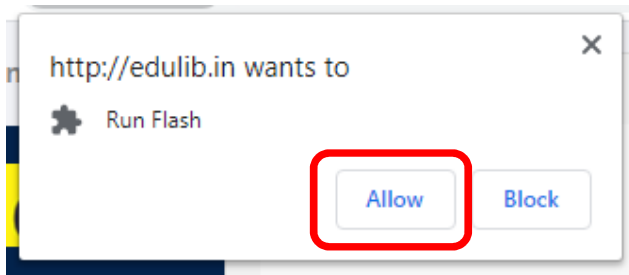


Open the content now in the browser, it asks to enable flash player to play the content. Click on the area shown.





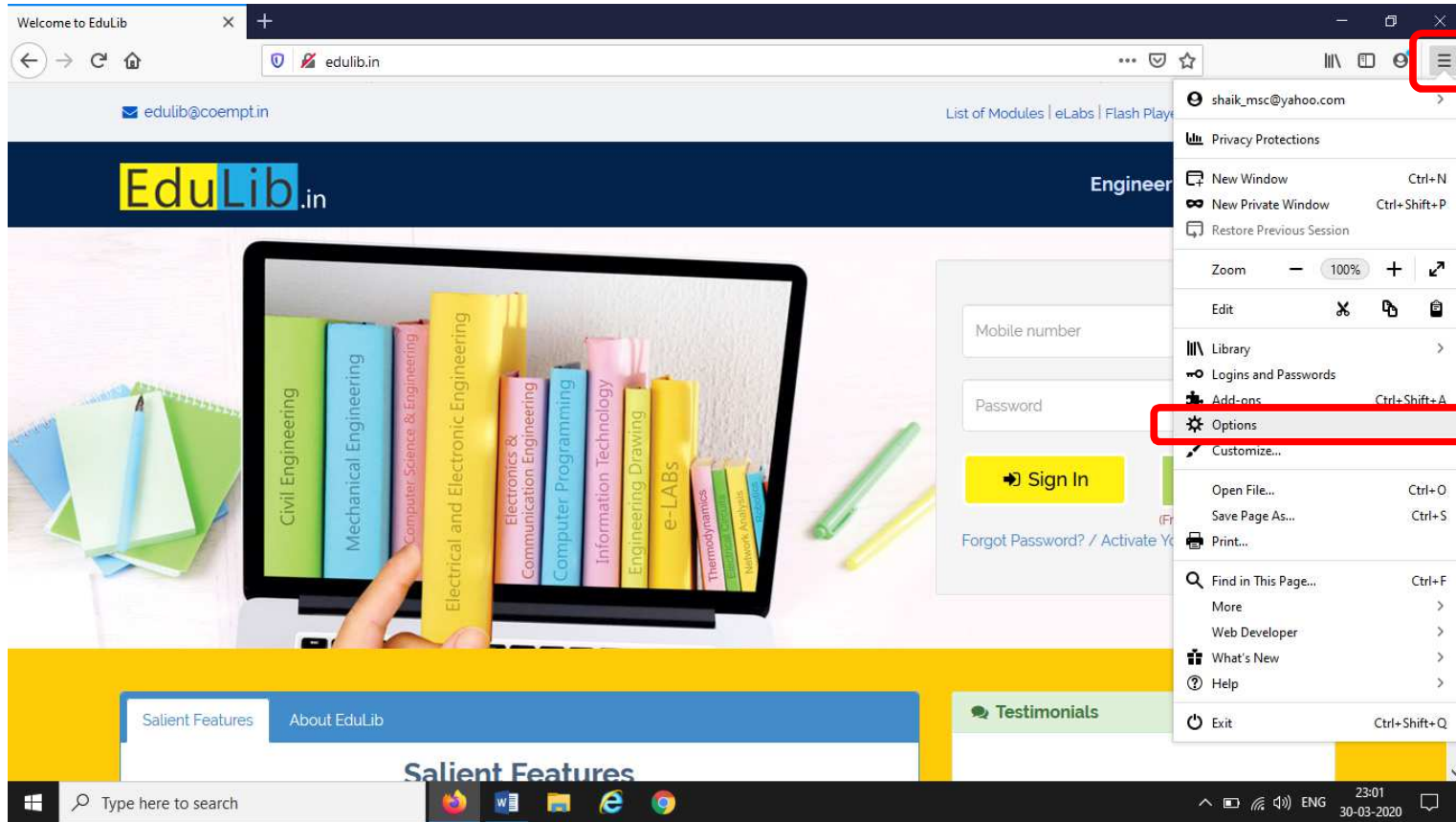
Click "Allow" to play flash content.



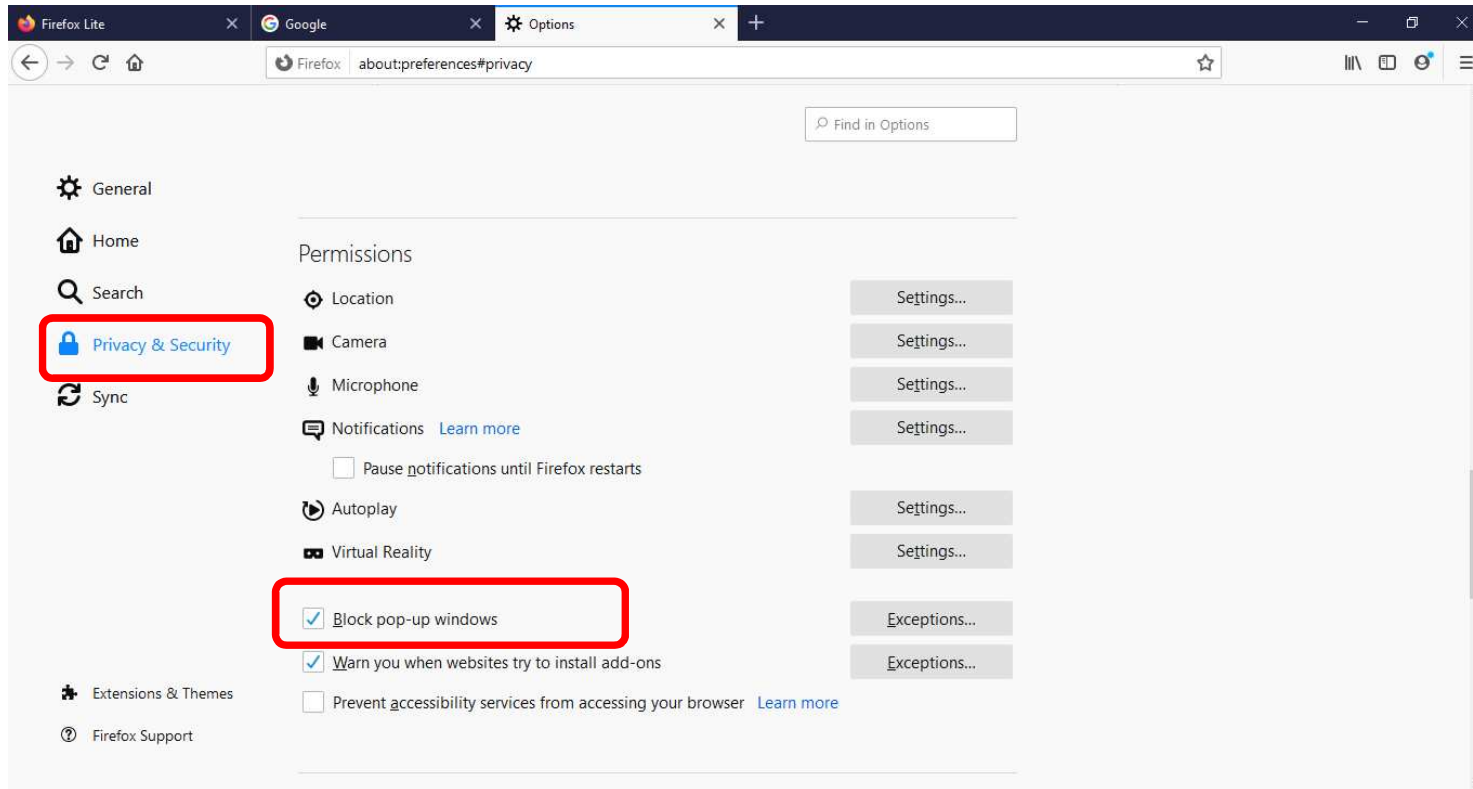

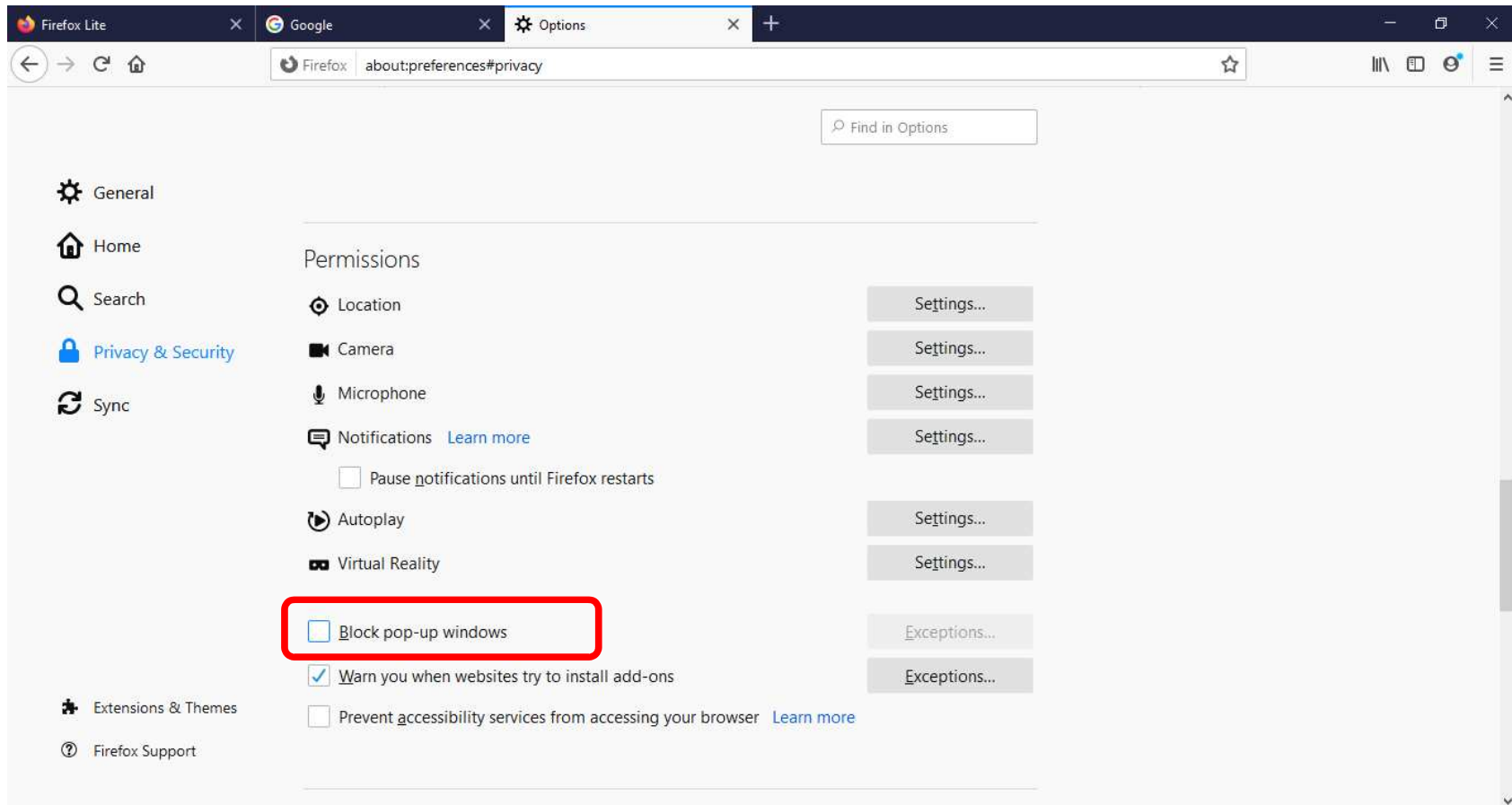
### Enabling Pop-up windows

Select "Privacy & Security" -> Un-check "Block pop-up windows" (Remove "tick"  mark)

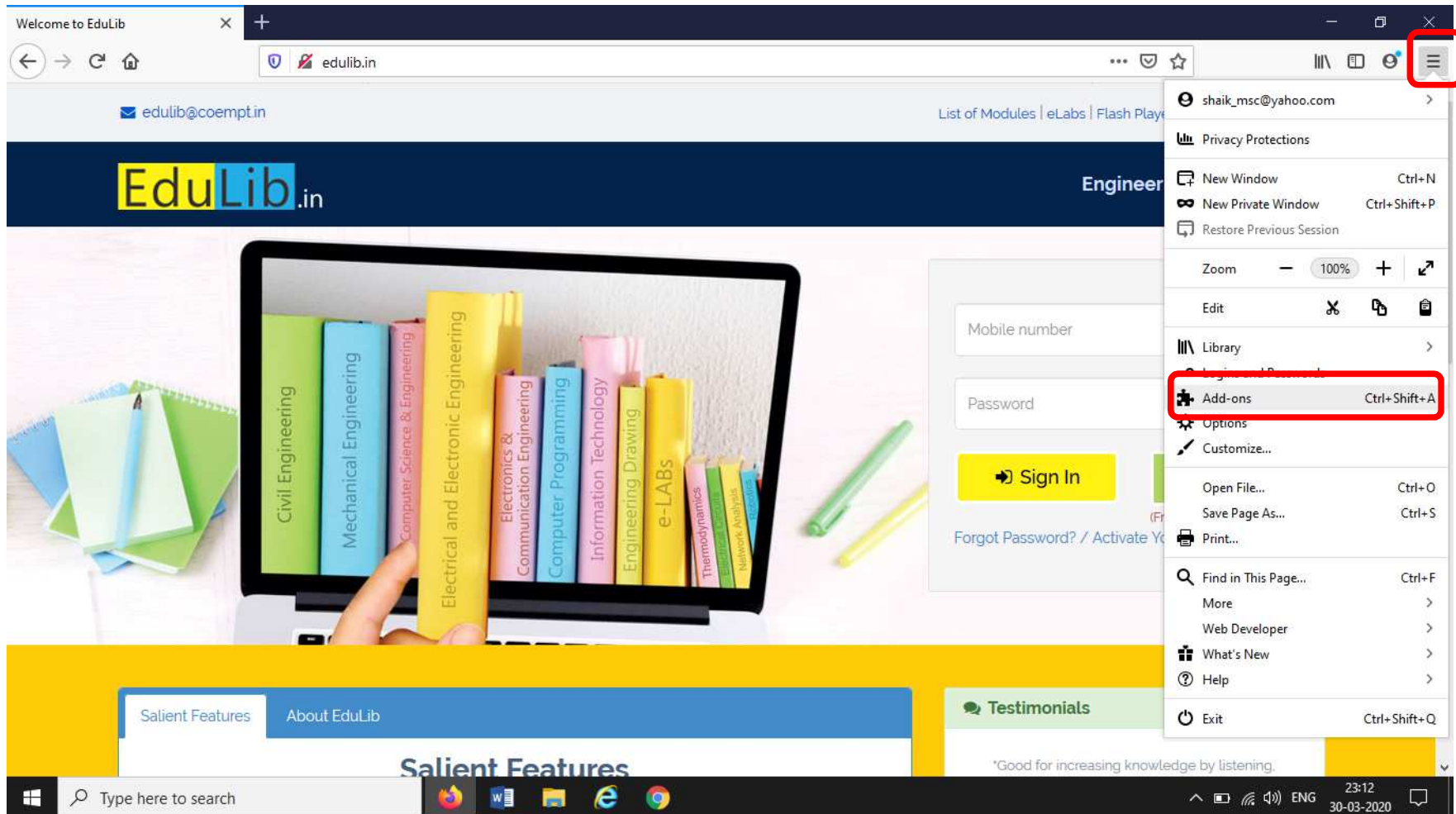




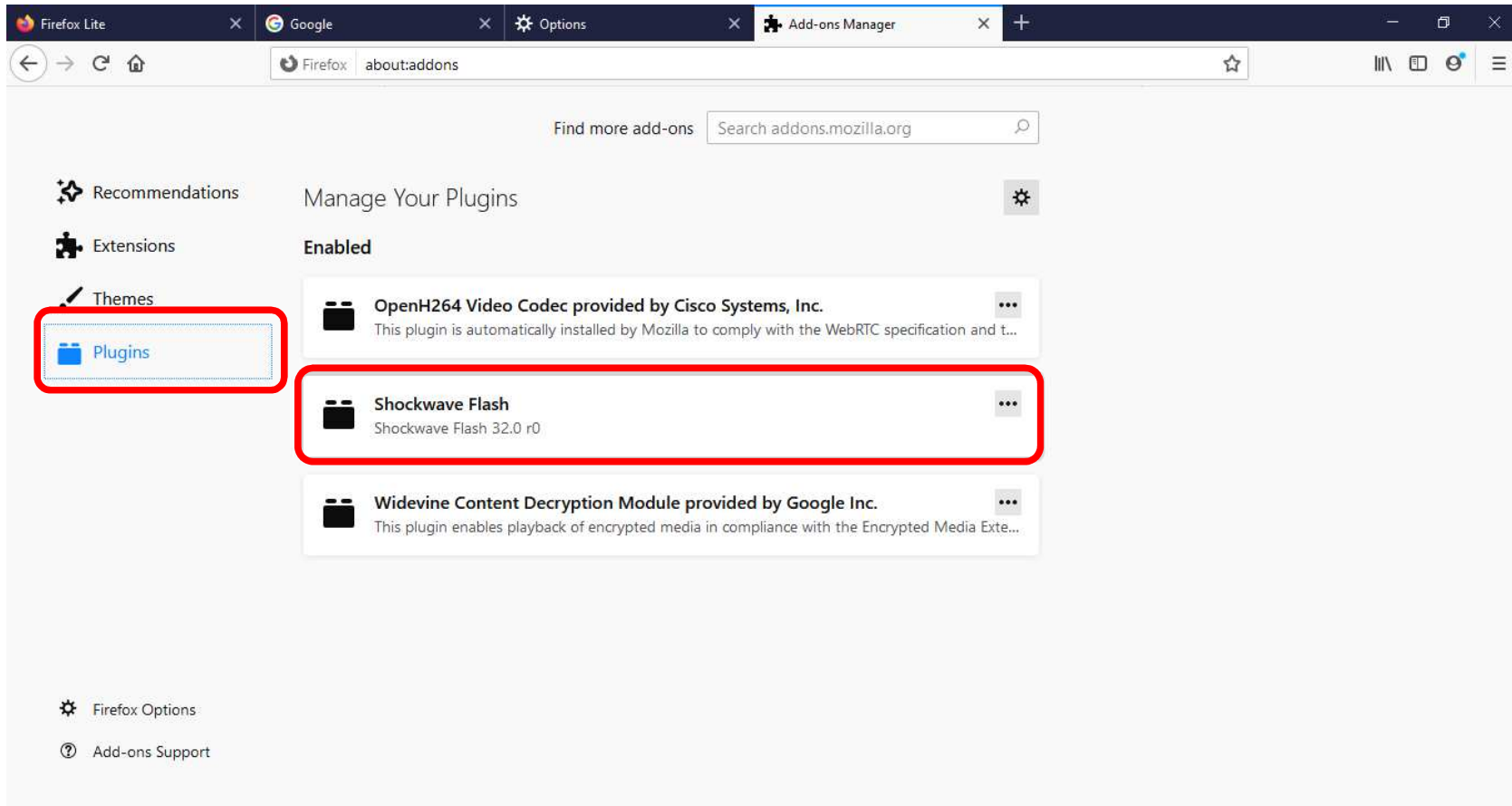
### Enabling Flash

Select "Settings" -> "Add-ons"

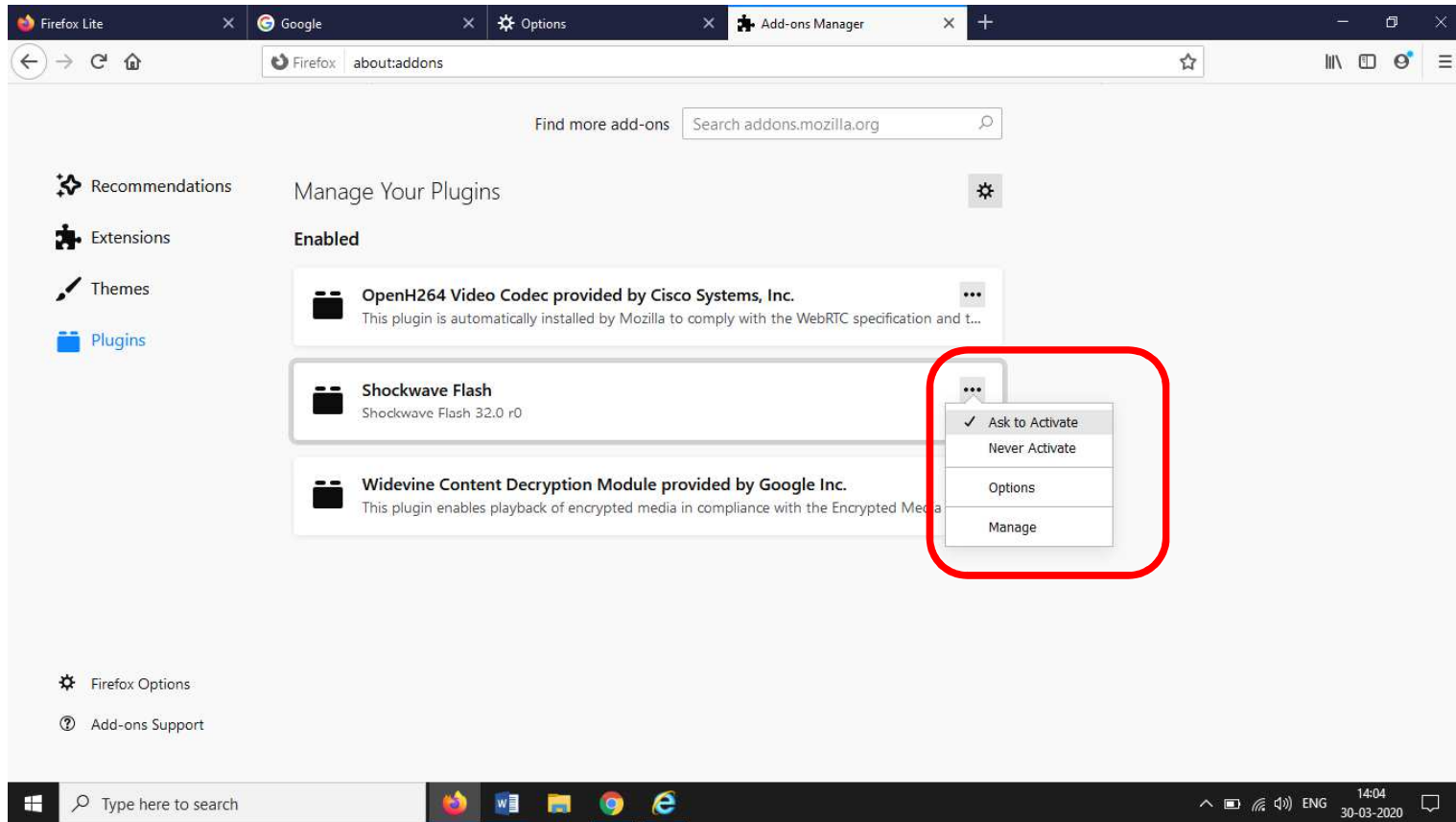

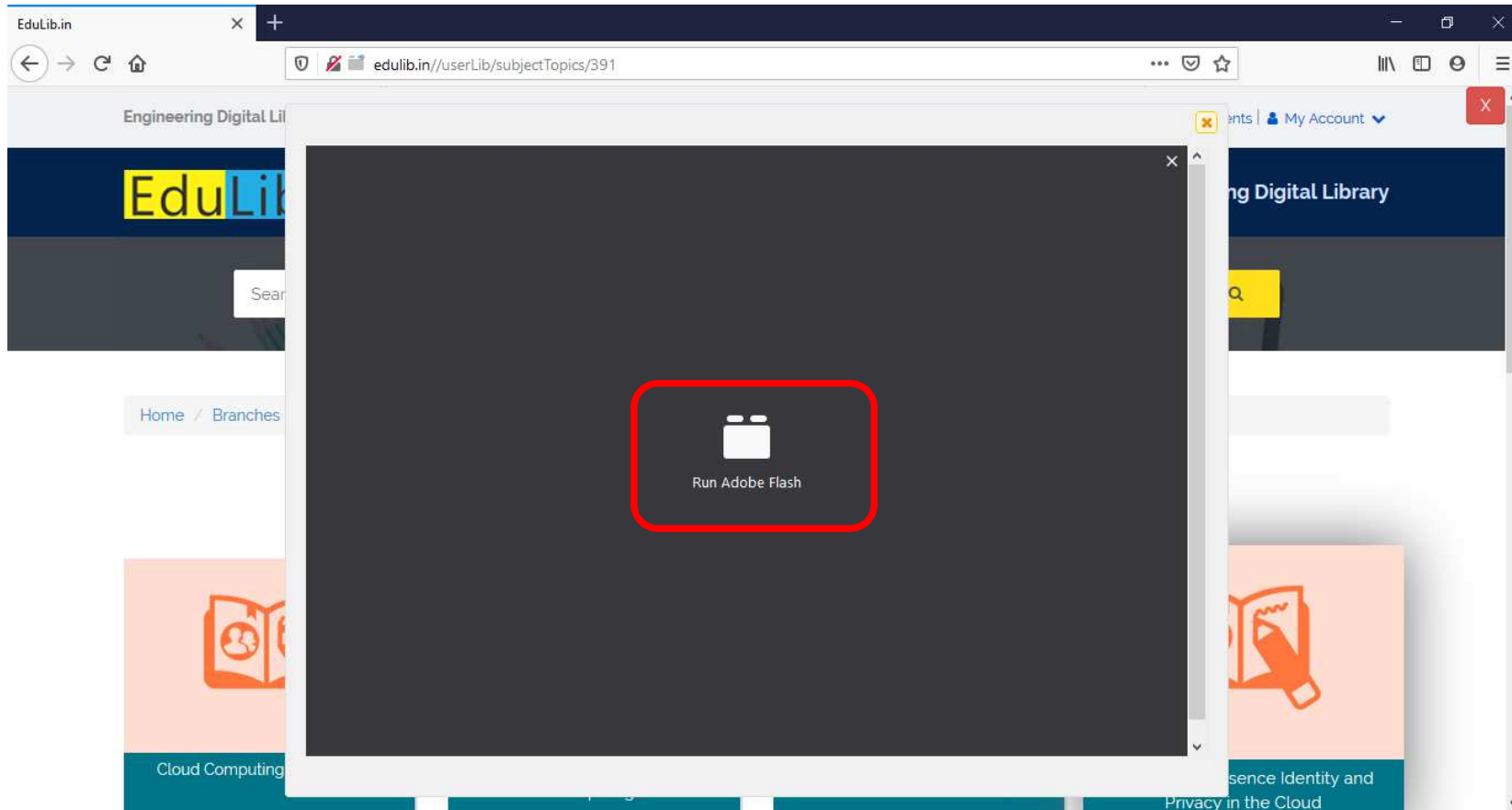
Select "Plugins" -> "Shockwave Flash"



Select “...” -> Enable “Ask to Activate” option

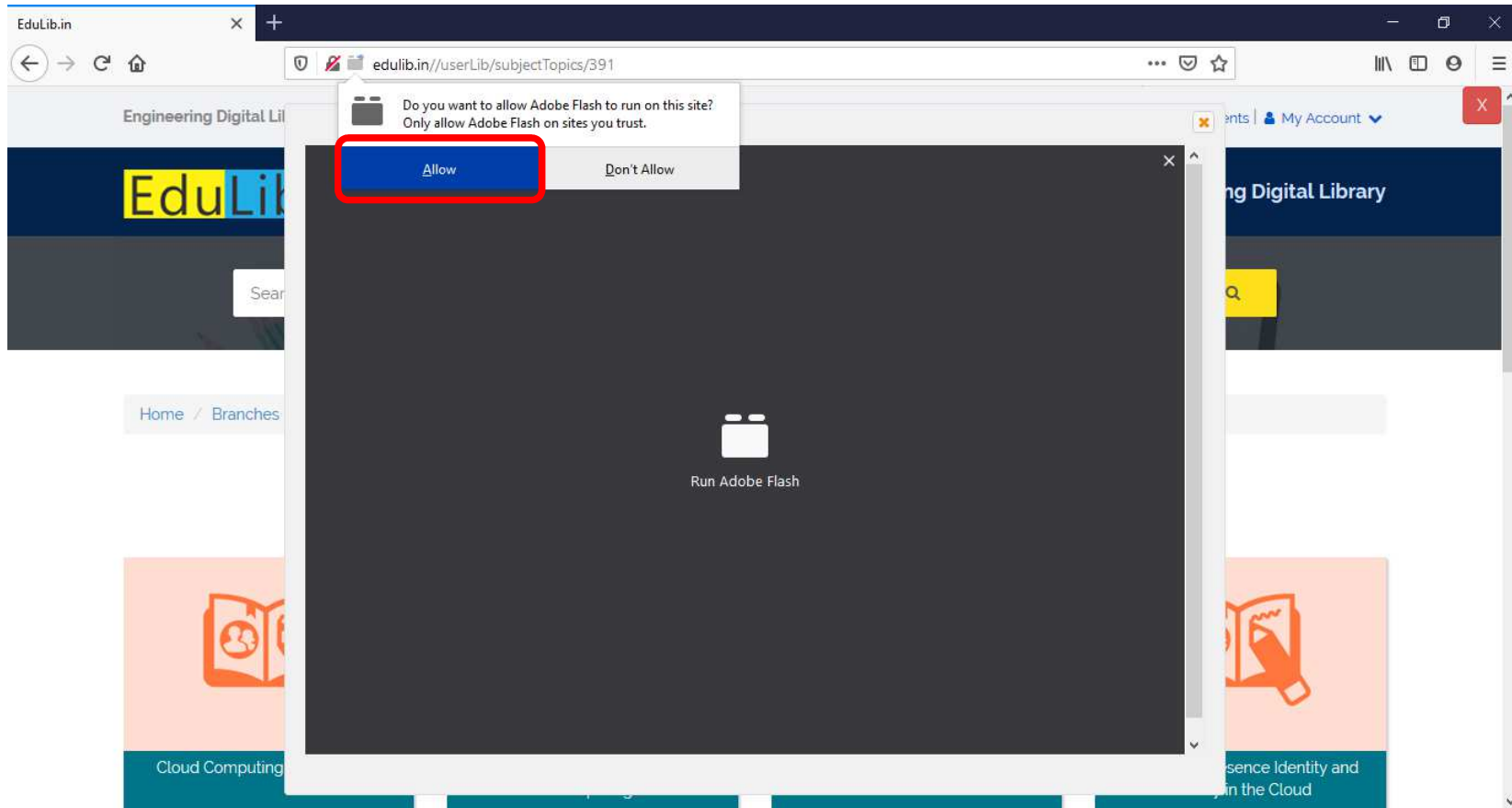


Open the content in the browser. It displays “Run Adobe Flash” in the window.





Select "Allow" to play Flash content.

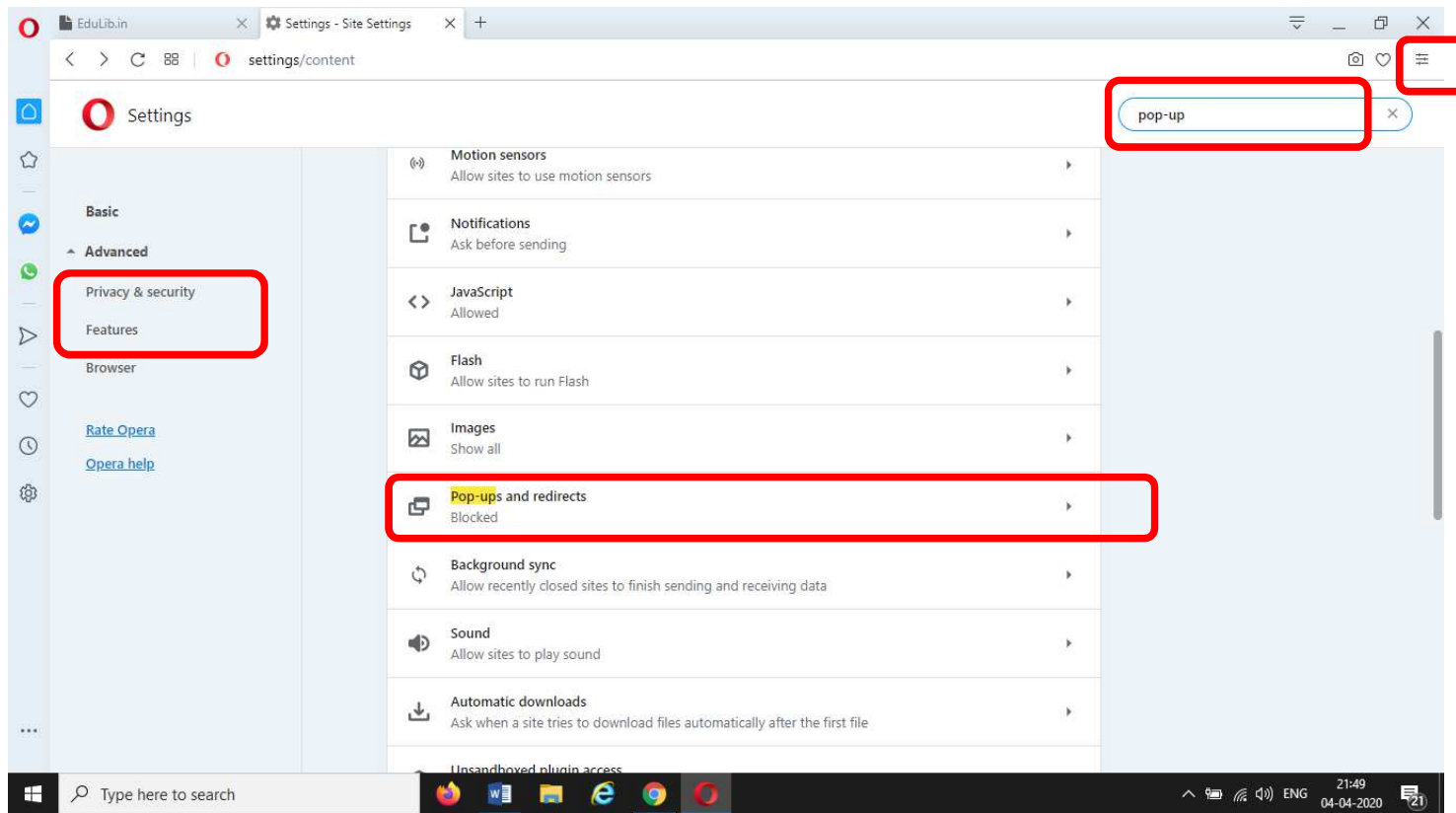

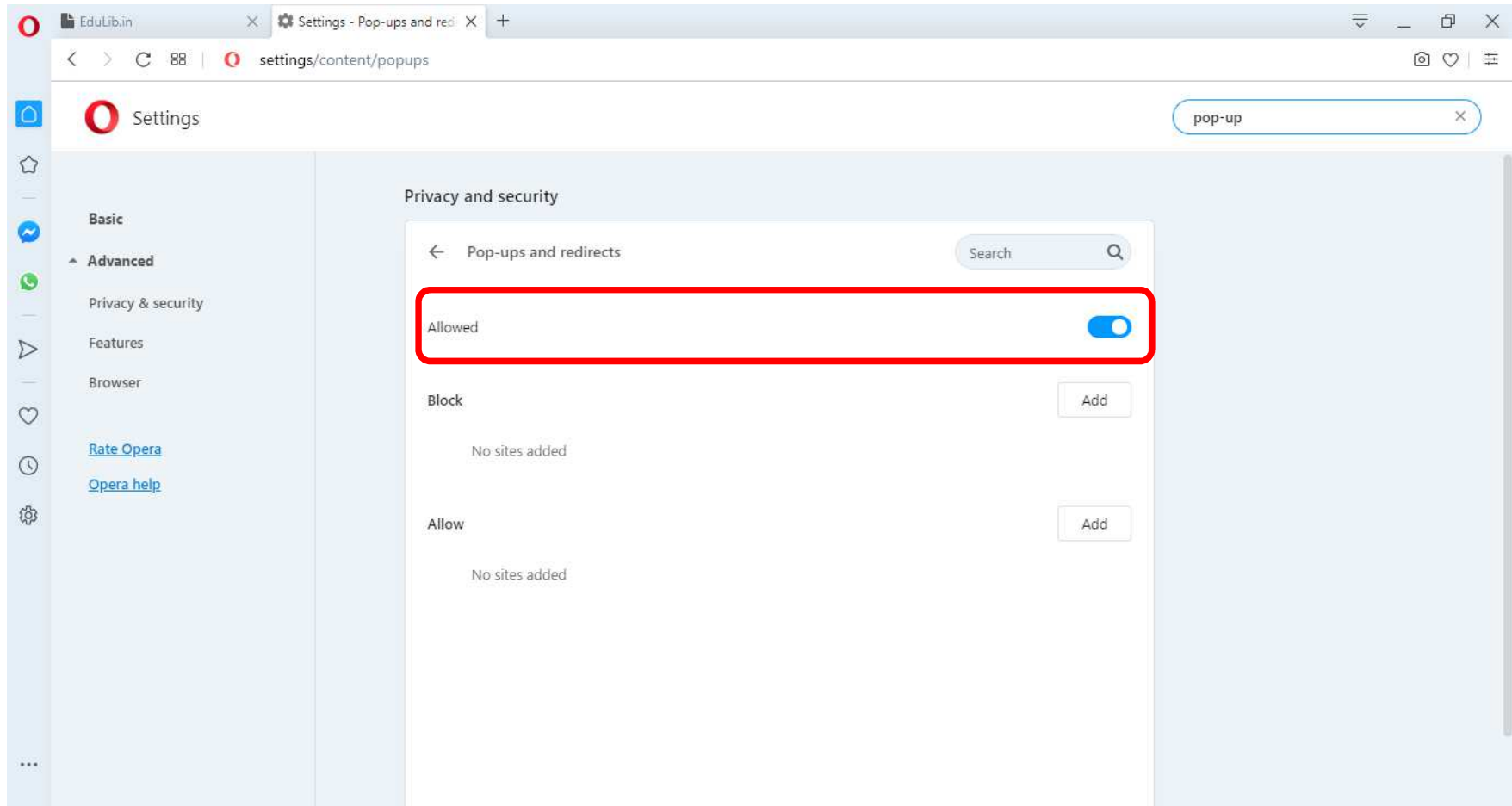

Opera Settings -> Advanced -> Privacy and security -> Site Settings -> Search Pop-up in Search box

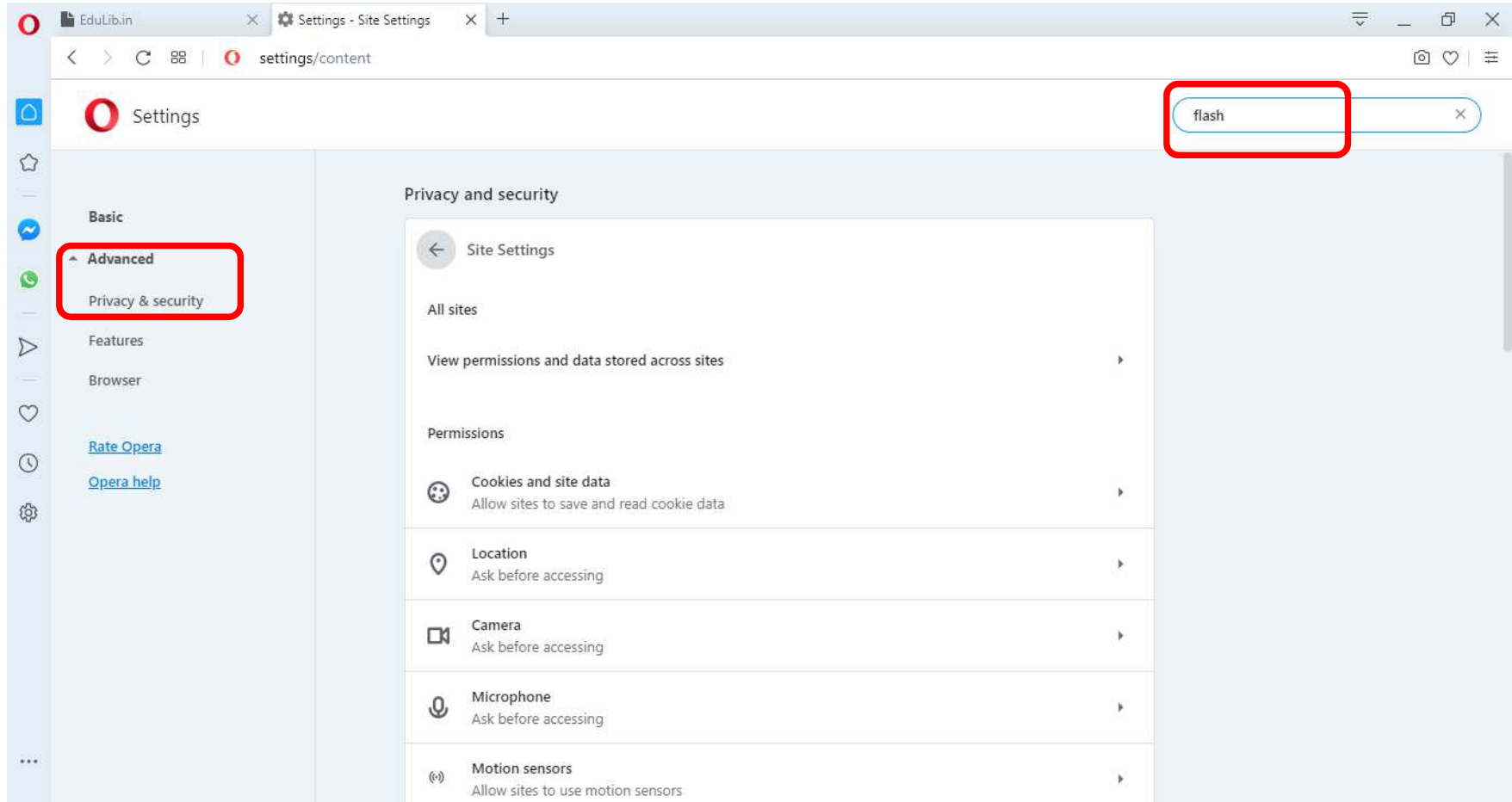

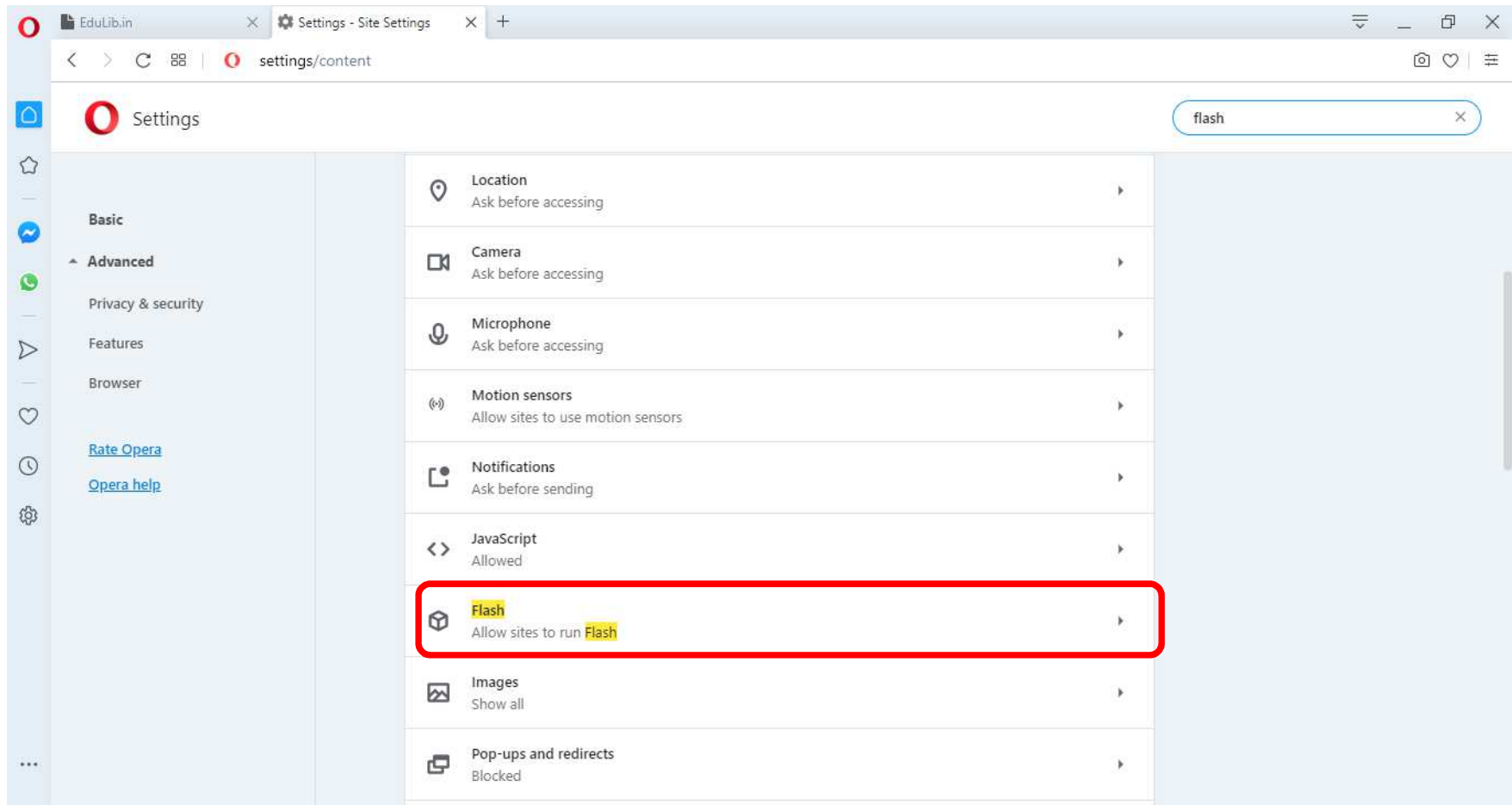


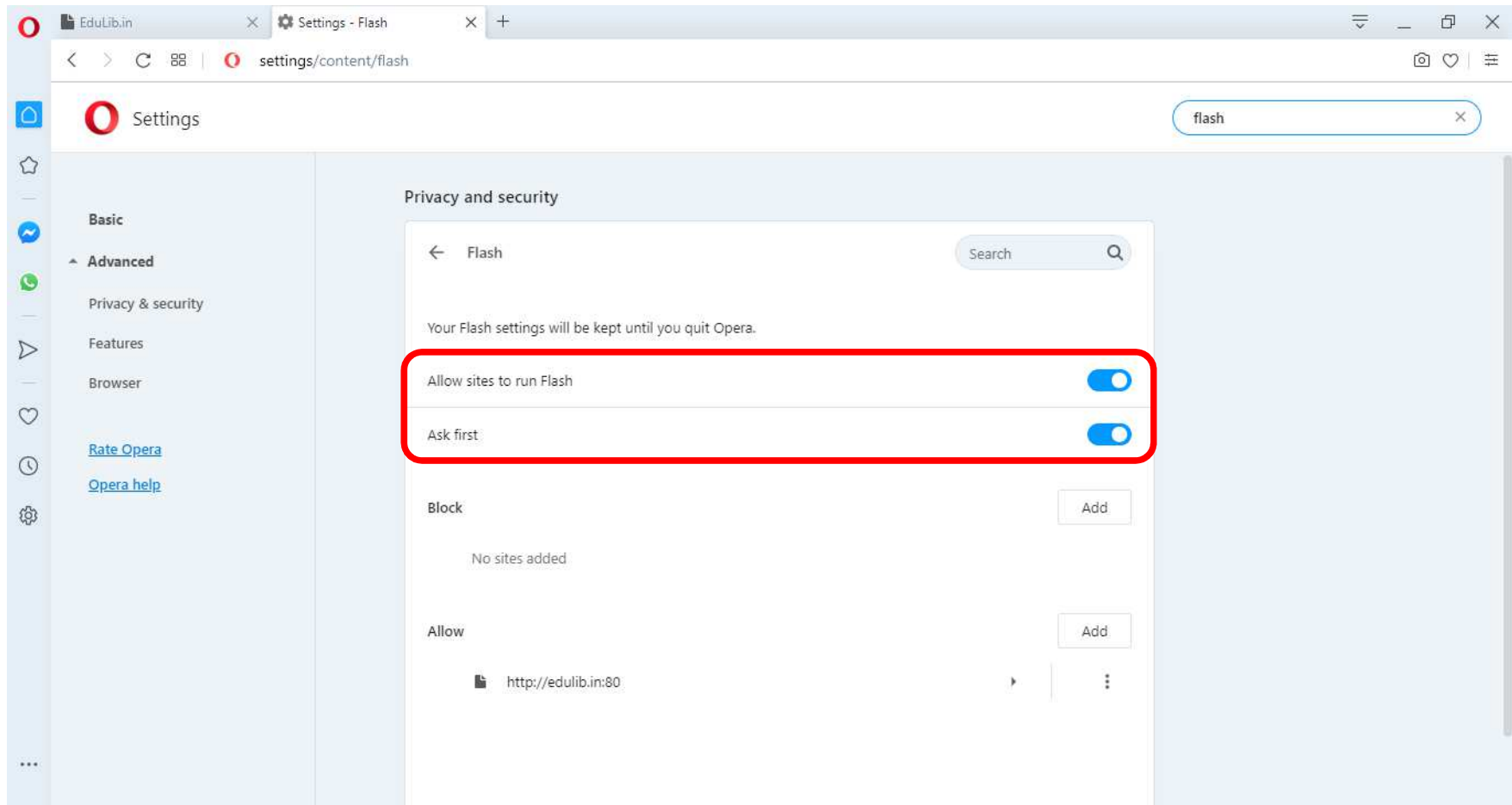
